

CLAYPITS PHASE 1 CAR PARK

Due for Construction 2025

- 1 New widened shared user path with new solar light poles. The new shared user path connects to the existing path and curves to maintain Disability Discrimination Act compliance and retain significant trees.
- 2 Raised pedestrian crossing with lighting.
- 3 Sealed and formalised car park above the lake's full supply level with linemarkings, signage and improved drainage.
- 4 Two x Disability Discrimination Act compliant car parking spaces with pram ramp access to footpath.
- 5 Vehicle turning circle.
- 6 Vehicle access to foreshore. Traffic control gates (closed during events and high lake water levels).
- 7 Long vehicle parking bays.
- 8 Standard car parking bays - 63 parking spaces.
- 9 Secondary paved footpaths for pedestrian movement separated from vehicle zones and connecting to the shared user path and existing toilet block.
- 10 Existing bins relocated.
- 11 New bubbler and new Disability Discrimination Act compliant path to toilet block.
- 12 Existing toilet block retained.
- 13 Existing 'chair lift seat' sculpture relocated.
- 14 New seat beneath new tree planting.
- 15 Informal lawn sloping toward foreshore and rock armour for bank stabilisation above the lake 'full supply level'.
- 16 Informal pedestrian access to foreshore.
- 17 Pop-up business opportunity area (e.g. kayak and paddle-board hire) with planting either side.
- 18 Future foreshore access ramp location to safe swimming area.
- 19 Informal path to safe swimming area.
- 20 Disc golf course retained with impacted baskets and holes relocated in consultation with the Rob Kneller Youth Foundation.
- 21 Future children's play space location.
- 22 Future picnic area.
- 23 Future formalised car park expansion and events access.
- 24 Existing foreshore path to be widened in future.
