Introduction


The lakes of Jindabyne and Eucumbene are popular areas for a range of activities and events. These events provide an opportunity to promote the region and are an important part of local community life.











Guide for holding foreshore events at Lake Jindabyne, Lake Eucumbene and surrounding areas

Approval timeframes

As processing can times differ significantly, event organisers should contact the relevant approval organisation at least six to twelve months before the date of their event. This will ensure that the approval process is complete on time.

Organisers should allow at least four months for NSW NPWS event approvals, with the length of time required for approval increasing in-line with event size and complexity.

For events requiring aquatic licences from Transport for NSW Roads & Maritime Services, it is recommended to apply a minimum of six weeks before the date of the event or activity. For complex events and events with longer lead times, organisers should submit applications further in advance.
